He has granted Catholics in Delaware and Maryland's Eastern Shore a dispensation from the obligation to abstain from meat for Saint Patrick's Day on Friday, March 17th. Catholics who take advantage of the dispensation, are encouraged to perform some other penance, such as abstaining from meat another day.

As a reminder for Catholics, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat. The norms concerning abstinence are binding upon members of the Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.
